### Description

Naut'sa mawt Tribal Council (NmTC) provides advisory services to its ten member First Nations in six core delivery areas: economic development, financial management, community planning, technical services, governance, and food security. NmTC food security advising, projects, services and programs cover a broad range of topics including but not limited to traditional food practices, hunting/ gathering & land access, and agriculture (i.e. livestock, orchards, market gardening).

Working under our Food Security Advisory, the Intern will assist with the development and implementation of the NmTC Seed Library, development of digital food and agriculture resources (i.e. toolkits, checklists, educational videos and pamphlets), and assist with coordinating and facilitating the Community Food Network workshops and webinars.
