Transition to BC Societies Act: November 2018

1. The name of the Society is NAUT'SA MAWT TRIBAL COUNCIL.
2. The purposes of the Society are:
 - (a) to create an environment in which socio-economic development can exist on Indian Reserves for Indian people;
 - (b) to create an environment for the development and implementation of Indian self-government on Indian Reserves for Indian people;
 - (c) to create an environment in which the delivery of services and programs to Indian people will be under the direct administration and control of Indian people;
 - (d) to create an environment in which Indian people may grow and prosper as the first ethnic race of North American people for the benefit of their future generations by the preservation of their pride and culture;
 - (e) to maintain administrative functions for the purpose of communications between Indian people;
 - (f) to assist individual Indian Bands and the Band Councils in British Columbia in carrying out their proper objects without interfering in the internal structure or with the lawful powers of such Bands and Council;
 - (g) to do all such things as are ancillary to, arise out of , or are necessary to carry out, the foregoing purposes.
