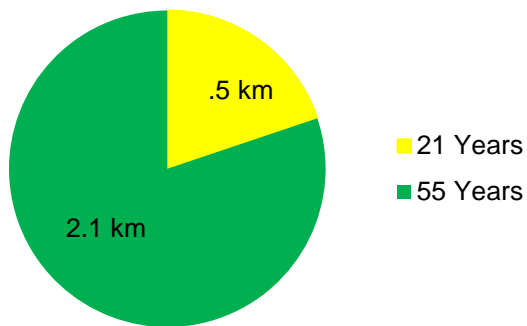


Current State of Assets: Water System

Our water system provides clean water to the homes in [Name of Community] community of [First Nation]. [First Nation] has a Municipal-Type Service Agreement (MTSA) with [Municipality] to receive its water supply. The community owns an underground system of pipes/water mains, service laterals, valves and hydrants.

This system also provides fire protection for the community. Fire hydrant maintenance is performed by the Public Works staff.

Age of Water Main Assets by Length (km)



Replacement Value: \$1.6M

Target Annual Investment: \$23K

Average Remaining Life: 22%

The water system is in generally good condition based on available information.

Critical assets are understood and [First Nation] is looking at long term planning for this infrastructure through the asset management program.
