The ETCP is designed to be delivered directly within communities, utilizing local environmental sites and conditions as the “classroom”. The ETCP courses and program are highly applied ‘hands-on’ training sessions, with field work, demonstrations, and/or field training taking place most days.

The ETCP series is comprised of a series of 1-week courses:

- Land Monitoring Skills (5 days)
- Water Monitoring Skills (5 days)
- Construction Site Monitoring Skills (5 days)
- Fish and Fish Habitat Monitoring Skills (5 days)
- Essential Environmental Skills (5 days)

Course Tuition is \$5,500 per participant.

NEW: The Environmental Technician Certificate Program is now accredited through the College of Applied Biology and meets all of the required criteria for the Applied Biology Technician designation.
